

Dear Teenage Cancer Trust,

Please find enclosed a cheque for £2,000 from Penguins Against Cancer, a charity set up to raise awareness of cancer and to provide support to cancer research and treatment organisations, and hospices. This follows the £2,658 grant raised by Jon de Mendonca via JustGiving in January 2015.

This grant, proposed by Pat Gush, our Acting President, was made possible following generous subscriptions from our members and very successful fundraising events at the Scanlan Memorial Cup rugby match (Penguins XV versus Guy's Hospital Students XV) and the Guy's Hospital Rugby Club ball, both held on 22nd April 2017. Of note, the Penguins, a number of whom were playing rugby for Guy's before their opponents were born, managed to beat the Students this year, 56-12, bringing to bear experience, age, weight and 20th century tactics to offset a certain shortfall in speed and fitness.
